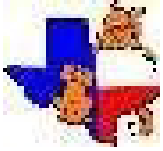

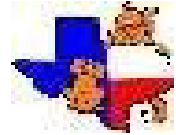

INFORMATION FOR FIRST TIME FOSTERS



This guide is for fosters who desire to rehome cats for whatever the reason

Fosters should drop off their cats (in carriers) by the designated time stated in the weekly text message. Most of the time it will be 11:00 AM Saturday morning. A little early or late is fine. You should plan to pick up your cat (if not adopted) by 3:00 PM. Please call or text if you need to vary from this schedule. If you wish to stay with your cat during the event, arrangements **MUST** be made in advance; preferably when you confirm kennel space. Those who wish to stay are expected to help setup @ 09:30 AM and or breakdown @ 3:00 PM. **Fosters must refrain from giving their personal information to adopters unless you have express information to do so from Ron McCuen or other Officer of Wags to Whiskers. This includes fees, policies, phone numbers, etc.**

All ADULT cats must be Spayed or Neutered, have a current paper 'certificate of rabies vaccination', be current on Worm and Flea treatments and have received an FVRCP vaccination. Microchipping is also required. W2W can provide microchip service if you wish.

KITTEN Information is on the last page and require a special program.

Cats must be strictly indoors for at least 14 consecutive days before bringing them to an adoption event. This gives any illness or disease time to become evident.

Cats must be contained in an appropriate pet carrier while transporting to and from the adoption event.

Cats **MUST** be able to be petted and handled by potential adopters. (There are exceptions to this rule)

My volunteers have appointed tasks and responsibilities. Please do not ask them to do things or tell them what to do. If you have a problem, let me know!!

Documentation required:

A cat **profile** for each adult cat, including a color photo.

A **Foster Agreement**. Multiple cats can be named on a single foster form.

No check marks! Please read and initial all paragraphs. Attach all available vet records if possible.

_____ *All adult CATS must have a current FVRCP & Rabies Vaccination, Be Spayed or Neutered, Wormed, Flea treatment & microchipped (W2W can microchip onsite). Cats must be strictly indoors for at least 14 consecutive days before bringing them to an adoption event. Documentation must be provided.*

_____ Fosters may not leave animals for adoption until all paperwork is complete and the animals have been examined.

_____ *PLEASE NOTE--An optional home visit may be performed before granting final foster approval.*

_____ All original profiles, veterinary records, photos, etc. *must* remain with Wags to Whiskers of Texas. Copies as applicable will be provided when the cat is adopted. A separate cat profile Must be provided for each cat. incomplete or missing documentation, (including a color photo of each cat), will result in refusal to present your animal for adoption at the discretion of Wags to Whiskers of Texas.

_____ Home care, feeding, Veterinary care, vaccines, flea treatment and spay/neuter are the responsibility of the Foster. Foster agrees to take cats back that are returned unless special arrangements are made with W2W. Expenses associated with foster care are tax deductible.

_____ **>>VERY IMPORTANT<<**Fosters must notify Wags to Whiskers of Texas if the animal is privately adopted out, or you decide to adopt them. Please obtain the adopters name, address, & phone so we can update our records & transfer microchip information to the adopter. Wags to Whiskers of Texas depends on donations to remain operational. The number of adoptions are critical to qualifying for corporate donations and is also required for nonprofit tax information. Please help us when you do a private adoption by agreeing to this requirement.



Wags to Whiskers of Texas Foster Agreement



Fosters must call or text 713-504-7838 by 3 PM Thursday of each week to reserve kennels. Animals brought in without a reservation may be refused.

Fosters, Volunteers & Counselors are strictly prohibited from paying or offering to pay adoption fees for potential adopters.

Please refrain from redirecting a potential adopter's attention to your cats when they are interested in another fosters cat! Failure to comply may result in your removal from the foster program.

Fosters are encouraged to participate in one or more of these tasks. The setup and breakdown of tables, kennels etc., Assisting with the adoption process and chores during the event. Fosters may pick and choose the days they can participate. It is not **REQUIRED to help, but greatly appreciated.**

CAT REHOMING SERVICE



Need to REHOME your cat? I can and will find the right forever family for your furbaby, BUT, you will have to do your part. Here are the requirements to join our foster program.

- 1. Must be spayed or neutered.**
- 2. Must have a current rabies vaccination (with certificate)**
- 3. Must be adoptable.(No ferals, aggressives, biters, etc.) If your cat can not be handled, it will not get adopted.**
- 4. Must be able to transport to and from our adoption location on Saturdays.**
- 5. Must complete a Foster agreement form.**
